Kit \$28 (pay in class):

Pattern for hearts, teacups, teapots, coffee pots, sugar, creamer and saucer.

Supplies for Templates:

Scissors for paper and scissors for fabric
Washable school glue stick
Scotch Tape
Mechanical Pencil
Paper
3-ring binder

Supplies for Appliqué:

Sewing machine and thread to match fabrics
Hand sewing kit with a variety of needles, threader and thimble
Iron, pressing sheet and ironing pad
Extension cord and light
Polyester "invisible" thread

One 6" square of each:

Steam-a-Seam 2 or Soft Fuse
Misty fuse

Fabric: May be scrappy or a selection of your favorite colors.

Please cut the background squares prior to class.

10-16 squares of background fabric 6½" x 6½".

18 squares for hearts and teacups at least 6". These do not need to be cut.

Three 12½" squares and two 8½" squares.

May bring a variety of fat quarters to make all the teapots.

Two 3" strips for scallops
